On February 4th through the 13th a group of people from Buffalo Valley will travel to the Dominican Republic to serve the Church of the Brethren there. We plan on doing some construction work and community building in two different places. We will start in San Jose (not sure Dionne Warwick knows the way to this San Jose...if you're under age 35...Google it) where we will make repairs to a church building in a Haitian community. Then when that project is finished we will travel to another location to work on a church building in a very impoverished part of the country.

This is our third trip in three years to the Dominican. As most of you know the Hoover family has arrived in the Dominican Republic to serve full time there. They will also help us on the ground in the Dominican. Buffalo Valley has had the privilege to really help to "restart" the American church's involvement in the Dominican. Praise God for this outcome.

How can you help? Well, you can pray for our group. As this Lamplighter goes out, we might still need one or two people to go on the trip. We also need to raise about \$10,000 in materials for the work we will be doing and you will in the future be asked to contribute to that need.

As a result of a decision at the Fall Council meeting our budget process will be changed. As of January 1, 2017 the repayment of the building debt has been included in the General Fund Budget.

Please combine your previous offerings to the two funds into one total General Fund offering effective January 1, 2017. An example of this would be that if someone gave \$300 to the General Fund and \$200 to the Building Fund for a total of \$500 at any time this past year, as of January 1, 2017 the total giving of \$500 would now be given to the General Fund.

Greetings from your Stephen Ministry Leaders!

We continue to have **eight Stephen Ministers ministering** to eight ladies in our faith community. Each week they meet for a time of encouragement, support and fellowship, and the reports from Care Receivers and Stephen Ministers reflects God's glory and each person being blessed.

We ultimately had only three people complete applications to undergo training to be new Stephen Ministers. Because of the role play and training requirements, we need at least six to have a successful training experience.

Our Stephen Ministers and Leaders will be individually approaching people throughout December to consider completing an application to become a Care Giver (aka Stephen Minister) through our Stephen Ministry.

We hope to begin the 50 hours of training during January, completing this in May, at which time new Stephen Ministers will be commissioned.

What's Cooking at Buffalo Valley

You will find DiAnne Beiler's **Peppermint Patties** recipe on page 168 of **Come to the Table cookbook!**

34 C. - sweetened condensed milk

1 ½ tsp. - peppermint extract

4 C. - confectioners' sugar

3 C. - semi-sweet chocolate chips

2 tsp. - shortening

In a large mixing bowl, combine condensed milk and peppermint extract. Beat in enough confectioners' sugar, a little at a time, to form a stiff dough that is no longer sticky. Form into 1-inch balls; place on wax paper and flatten with fingers to form a patty. Let patties dry at room temperature for 2 hours; flipping once. In medium saucepan over low heat, melt chocolate chips with shortening, stirring often. Once melted, remove from heat. Dip patties, one at a time, into chocolate. Let cool on wax paper until set. Wrap as desired. For Christmas and holidays, add food coloring to milk and peppermint base.

This recipe will make about 30 peppermint patties. I used fat-free sweetened condensed milk when I made them. And, since I had dark chocolate coating wafers on hand, I used them instead of the semi-sweet chocolate chips. When you prepare this recipe, I would suggest you use a Kitchen Aid type mixer. I started out with my handheld mixer and that did not work well. The dough is very thick.

There are numerous candy recipes in **Come to the Table cookbook**, some of which would be great for the holidays! Cookbooks are available at the Welcome Center on Sunday mornings. The cost is \$10 each and they make great gifts.

2016 and 2017 Budget Correction

While finalizing the Pastoral Contracts for 2017, it was discovered that there was a mistake made in years of service credited to Pastor Donita. She was paid on scale for 8 years of service in 2015 and again on the 8 years scale for 2016. The intent was to pay her on scale for years of service which should have been 9 years. She would then be on 10 years of service for 2017.

The Ministry Coordinating Team (MCT) approved to pay Pastor Donita the difference (\$1,128) between step 8 and step 9 for 2016 and an additional \$135 to the pension fund.

For Budget year 2017, MCT also approved the difference between step 9 and step 10 (\$1,174) and the additional \$141 for the pension cost. The 2017 total budget figure for Associate Pastor for Children and Pastoral Care is \$58,362.

These actions will be on the agenda for the May Congregational Business Meeting for affirmation.
