#### The Mixing of Politics and Religion

In the recent confirmation hearing of Russell Vought to be the Deputy Director of the Office of Management and Budget, Senator Bernie Sanders said some things that in my view are very troubling, yet not unexpected. In fact, I think that many people would have espoused the opinion of Senator Sanders and that is why I'm writing this letter. don't have time to write about the entire incident, Russell Vought had previously written an article where he said, "Muslims do not simply have a deficient theology. They do not know God because they have rejected Jesus Christ His Son and they stand condemned." Senator Sanders kept asking Mr. Vought if he believed that Muslims and Jews were condemned. Mr. Vought never answered the direct question, probably under advice from those who counseled him in this process. Senator Sanders ended his remarks by saying, "This nominee is really not someone who is what this country is supposed to be about I will vote "no" "

My concern is not with Senator Sanders. My concern is that Russell Vought simply wrote about a basic and fundament truth of scripture regarding salvation. Anyone, regardless of his religious label, who does not know Jesus Christ stands condemned. And the only way to remove that condemnation is through Jesus Christ. John 3:18 says, "He who believes in Him (Jesus) is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God." The Bible is very clear that because of our sin, we all stand condemned. Mr. Vought's earlier article was simply stating this point.

I suppose my letter to you is not really about the mixing of politics and religion but rather does your religion inform the rest of your life? If you are unwilling to stand up for what you believe then what good is what you believe? I wish that Mr. Vought had simply

answered the question, "Yes, I do believe that all Muslims and any other people, including you, Senator Sanders, who have not received Jesus Christ as Savior stand condemned." But he didn't say that. He probably didn't want to be on the news and all over the internet any more than he is now.

However, please understand that what we continue to see in our country, and I don't think it's going to change, is that by believing and expressing basic biblical teaching about salvation you will be accused of being "islamophobic", "racist" or "bigoted". You and I will need to decide whether our convictions are worth standing for or not. People say we should not mix politics and religion. I say that religion should mix into every aspect of your life and it is increasingly clear that there is a price to pay if that religion is biblical Christianity.

- One box of 24 crayons (only 24)



# When Can I Reserve This Facility?



activities. However, the priority use of the building is for ministry functions and events.

In order to facilitate this process, we do not reserve the use of the church building for parties and gatherings until the church's ministry events have been placed on the calendar. Here is how the process works.

Each ministry team at Buffalo Valley must provide the dates of their ministry events by October 1st. At that time our church calendar for the following year is put together, with any discrepancies resolved. Then, on November 1st, the calendar is opened up to receive reservations from the congregation for nonchurch sponsored events. For example, if you would like to host a birthday party in the Sonroom in April of 2018, we cannot reserve that room for you until after November 1, 2017. The only exception is for the use of the facility for a wedding that normally requires a large amount of advanced planning. This procedure allows us to make sure the required church events get on the calendar and eliminates conflicts or the need for someone to reschedule a previously reserved engagement.

# What's Cooking at Buffalo Valley

Jan Kline's **Three Fruit Smoothies** recipe is found on page 16 of **Come to the table cookbook**.

1 (11.5-oz.) can - frozen Welch's Strawberry Breeze juice concentrate, thawed

1 (8-oz.) container - vanilla yogurt

1/2 C. - milk

1 T. - honey

1 tsp. - vanilla extract

1 pt - fresh or frozen strawberries, pulled

1 lg - banana, cut in chunks

1 C. - fresh or frozen peaches, peeled and chopped

Place ingredients in a blender; cover and process until smooth. Pour into glasses. Serve immediately.

I was unable to find the Welch's juice concentrate this recipe calls for, so I used Old Orchard strawberry daiquiri juice concentrate. The result was a slightly tangy fruit smoothie. It was delicious!

I used frozen berries and peaches. The smoothie kept well in my refrigerator for about three days and tasted like it was freshly made!

There is a **Party Punch** recipe that Myrna Goss submitted that is found on page 15 of **Come to the Table cookbook** as well!

If you don't have a cookbook you can purchase one for \$10 at the Welcome Center.
