“Follow God’s example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ did... But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God’s holy people.” - Eph. 5:1-3

I struggle with verse 3 here - it’s all positive (love, forgive...) then this negative judgement type language. Maybe because I’ve seen the church and religious people judge what we deem as sexually immoral or impure, and greedy (though we tend to go lighter on the latter). It’s tempting to just skip over these verses, but we must struggle with them.

I note 2 quick things: 1st, it is AMONG us, not in the general public. Also, these charges are surrounded by the positive commands to love, forgive, and bear with one another. Even our judgement (especially of ourselves) must be soaked in love.

Ok, one other quick note - it’s easy to pick a hot button judgement that shows we are “right” (confirmation bias). The challenge is to examine ourselves and see if any of these exist in me, and work on that... with love, forgiveness, and patience.
